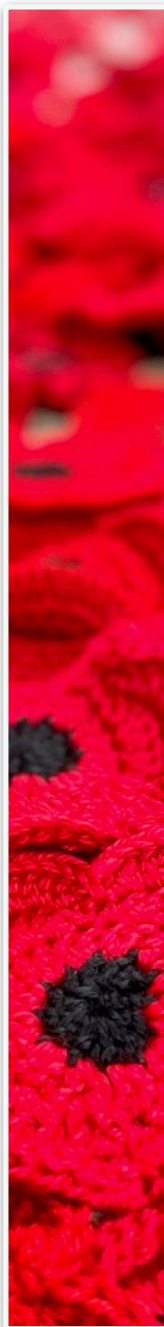


Contributors to the St. John's Elora Poppy Project 2021

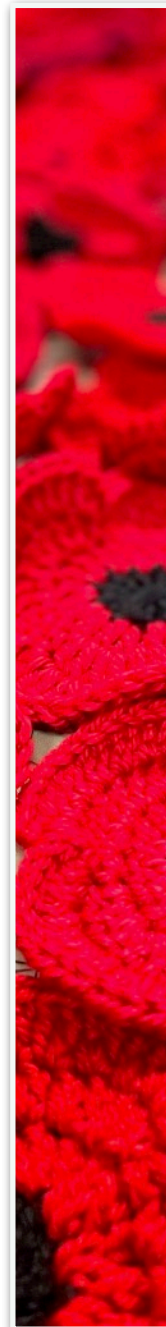

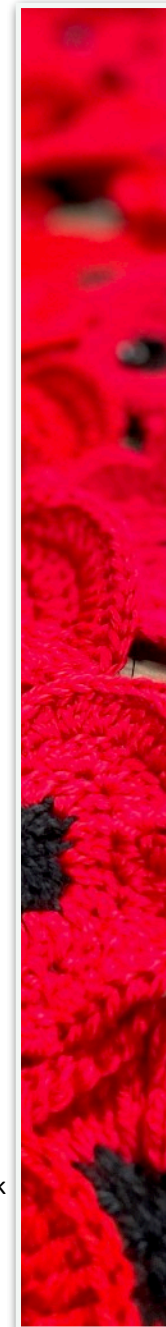

The St John's Poppy Project

was inspired by the Anglican Cathedral Church of the Redeemer in Calgary (2018) and the Cambridge (Ontario) Poppy Project (2021).

The St John's Elora Knitters and Quilters group launched a similar project to mark the centenary of the poppy as symbol of peace and remembrance.

Initially we asked for 1,500 poppies and we ended up with 7,167 poppies!

The poppy has many different meanings - it recalls the sacrifices that were made and it is a remembrance of the tragic costs of war. The poppy is also a powerful symbol of the importance of striving for peace in the world and to not repeat the mistakes of the past.

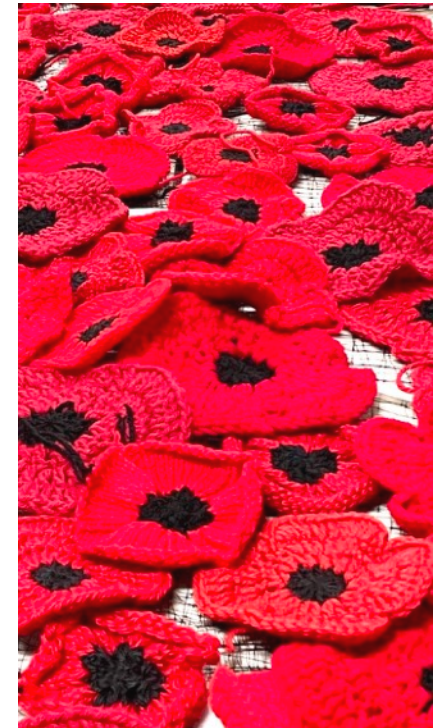
THE OUTDOOR ART INSTALLATION
