PWRDF now assists a third implementing partner working inside the war-ravaged country. With a grant \$62,000 **Initiative E+** will purchase medical supplies to treat wounded civilians.

Since 2014, the non-governmental organization **Initiative E+** has been spearheading medical and social humanitarian projects in and around Kyiv and in Eastern Ukraine. With the help of

donations from all around the world they provide medicine and equipment to both civilian and military hospitals, first aid kits and PPE to first responders and activities and camps for children living near war zones. For example, in the last month, Initiative E+ has purchased external fixation devices for keeping fractured bones stabilized and immobilized; tactical medical supplies for first responders; medical equipment for hospitals and medicine.

The PWRDF grant will be used to supply general medicine for the civilian population, equipment for hospitals and medical centres, and PPE and medical supplies for Ukrainian military personnel and first responders.
