Last year we received over 7,000 poppies. Help expand the outdoor art installation of knitted and crocheted poppies in November 2022 to other sites around Elora and Fergus.



Here's how you can participate:

1. Knit or crochet poppies. Patterns are available on St John's Elora website - www.stjohnselora.ca. Kits with yarn are also available in the "Poppy Bin" on the porch of the Henderson Street entrance to the St. John's Parish Centre (yellow house at the corner of Geddes and Henderson Streets in Elora).
2. Deliver your completed poppies to the "Poppy Bin" on the porch of the St John's Parish Centre before September 30, 2022.
3. Let us know if your business wants to host an outdoor poppy banner.
4. Help assemble the poppy banners in September and October at St. John's Church, Elora.
